VALVE COVER RACING

Lots of folks get a huge kick out of watching the Valve Cover Car Races at our car show, BUT this bit of car show fun is even more exciting if you PARTICIPATE! Start by getting involved and building a car and be ready for the races on car show day. Start with your favorite throwaway **small block valve cover** and follow these guidelines and you’ll be competing in no time.

Must use any small block valve cover. No big blocks, sorry.
Gravity race --- no propulsion of any kind.
Wheels must be affixed to solid suspension only. No springs or shocks.
No moving parts except for wheel rotation.
Overall outside car width is 10.5 inches maximum, wheel to wheel.
Wheels cannot extend BEYOND the front & rear of the valve cover.

Wheels CANNOT exceed 4 inches in diameter and are limited to 4 in total.
Car may be decorated or painted (or not) any way you want.
Finished total weight cannot exceed 8 pounds. All weights must be fixed.
No liquid filled weights.
Open to all contestants, with or without a Drivers License.

That’s it! It is that easy and you can have a ball competing with a car you’ve made yourself. Maybe even win a racing award! So get, busy, whack one together and bring it to the show. **Racing starts at 12 noon. Awards to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners AND for best-decorated valve cover car.**
